The archipelago of the Îles de la Madeleine <http://www.tourismeilesdelamadeleine.com/> is located in the middle of the Gulf of St-Lawrence, or more precisely: 215 km from the Gaspé peninsula, 105 km from Prince Edward Island and 95 km from Cape Breton Island. The Island chain takes the shape of an extended fishhook stretching across a distance of 65 km. The archipelago comprises about a dozen islands, six of which are interconnected by long, thin, sand dunes.

The keys to the originality of Madelinot culture lie in its Acadian and Quebec influences and in the fact that the Islands remained isolated for a very long time. This feeling of community is still alive and well today, and its originality gives the Islands a little something extra: a difference which, when coupled with the landscape, is a "breath of fresh air".

You will be surprised and charmed right from the start by the melodic intonations of the Acadian accent, the marine terminology, and archaic words from ancestral France. In the Islands, the pace of life is different, it is said that time flows to another rhythm; in the Islands... it's not the same...

We will travel round trip by the daily ferry service <http://www.ctma.ca> between Souris, Prince Edward Island and the Îles de la Madeleine. This 5-hour ferry crossing allows you to combine a tour of the Atlantic Provinces. The M.V. Madeleine is a very comfortable ship offering a multitude of services such as a cafeteria, dining room, movie theatre, daycare centre, cabins, entertainment.

We will be staying near the ferry dock (4km) . Our campground, *Parc de Gros-Cap* has all services and is surrounded by the sea on top of the red carved cliffs. It has direct access to the beach, great views and Internet wire-less.
