Yellowstone National Park www.nps.gov/yell/index.htm is America's first national park. Located in Wyoming, Montana and Idaho, it is home to a large variety of wildlife including grizzly bears, wolves, bison, and elk. Preserved within Yellowstone National Park are Old Faithful and a collection of the world's most extraordinary geysers and hot springs, and the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone.

Experience Old Faithful, the most popular geyser in the world, and hundreds of other geysers and hot springs. Look for bears and wolves, elk and buffalo in the Lamar and Hayden Valleys. Hiking, camping, fishing, enjoying exhibits and films, and attending Ranger-led programs are among the many ways to experience Yellowstone.

During our visit to the park you will have the opportunity to view herds of free roaming elk and bison and geothermal attractions such as Old Geyser, Mammoth Hot Springs, and even a "super volcano." Every sight you see will take your breath away, such as the petrified trees did to the earliest American explorers.
